7. Liaison Updates

- a. Finance and Operations Update April
 - i. Undergraduate scholarship recommendations were submitted (merit awards), still waiting on FAFSA information (UI has not received anything from the Department of Education). Will then award financial need-based scholarship once information is received.
 - ii. Budget review meeting was held. Went through all revised revenue projections for current year.
 - iii. Tuition and fees proposal for the upcoming academic year has been submitted to Provost Office for review and consideration.
 - iv. Preparing for the end of fiscal year (June 30). Email sent out to request carry over funds. Due on April 1. Approvals will be sent out to requesters by the first week of May.
 - v. FY 25: Application for building budget is open after Spring break and start the process of budgeting for the year which includes forecasting enrollment, student financial aid, employee headcount, research expenditures, and indirect cost recoveries.
 - vi. Facilities: There is now a collegiate role for space survey application which will provide the college the ability to add and remove users for the space survey application and run reports.
 - vii. College of Engineering Facility and Operations Coordinator position interviews happened last week and candidates are being reviewed based on evaluations received.
 - viii. There are 75 new chairs coming for graduate spaces and common spaces throughout the Seamans Center.
- b. HR Update Diane
 - i. Staff updates: HR team is working on P/S and faculty searches.
 - 1. Hope to have finalized in the next month or so
 - ii. Working at Iowa survey may be integrated with Campus Climate survey to consolidate surveys
 - iii. Faculty/Staff Immigration Services updated services effective March 1 to prioritized supporting faculty positions
 - 1. If need for expedited services, Faculty/Staff Immigration is providing recommendations for legal services
 - iv. Minimum P&S position requirements for sponsorship of foreign nationals must be a MS or higher OR a bachelors and 5 years of relevant experience
 - v. HR is reviewing P/S job descriptions and updating them with new universal competencies
 - vi. Talent Aquisition is offering technology to post jobs on HR engineering page.
